On Thursday, November 12 Metropolitan-Archbishop Borys Gudziak of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Philadelphia will present a program entitled: *Quo Vadis: The Direction of Eastern Catholic Theology, a Pastoral Perspective for the 21st Century. Distinct in their liturgy, theology, spirituality, and discipline of Church life, 23 Eastern Churches are in communion with the Roman Catholic Church. The Second Vatican Council urged the Eastern Catholic Churches to cultivate and promote their unique share of the tradition. This series responds to that mandate and features leading scholars in the field to offer their theological perspectives drawn from the wisdom of Christian East. In view of broadening our understanding of the Catholic intellectual tradition, this series draws attention to the vantage points of Christians who worship, think, and pray in continuity with the first 1,000 years of the undivided Church.*

COVID-19 State of Ohio Face Mask Mandate - Governor Mike DeWine enacted a state-wide mask mandate for all Ohioans. This mandate is still in place.
